

## HOW TO VOTE USING THE M100 Optical Scanner

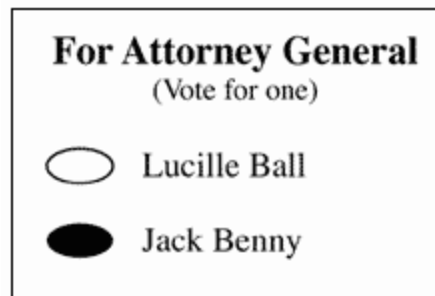
Voters in Pulaski County will notice that the ESS manufactured Eagle III Optical Scanner has been replaced with a newer model called the M100.

Voters use a pen to mark a paper ballot that is then placed in the optical scan machine at the precinct. Voters will fill in an oval beside the candidate's name they wish to select. The ballot is then fed into the scanner and the machine "reads" the ballot and tabulates the votes. The Model 100 Optical Scan machine alerts voters to [over-voted](#) races and [under-voted](#) ballots.

### 1, 2, 3, Vote

- 1. Receive Ballot**  
A poll worker will issue a paper ballot and direct you to a voting booth.
- 2. Select Candidate**  
To select your candidate, use a pen to fill in the oval beside the candidate's name you wish to choose.
- 3. Review Ballot**  
After completing your ballot, check over each race to make sure you have marked the ballot as you intended. If you make a mistake, simply ask the poll worker for another ballot.
- 4. VOTE!**  
When finished making your choices, insert your ballot into the optical scanner. If you have over-votes or under-votes, the scanner will alert you and you will have the opportunity to correct your ballot.
