NOTICE OF ELECTIONEERING

(Pursuant to State Law A.C.A. §7-1-103 & §7-1-104)

PROHIBITION

Electioneering is prohibited in the building or within 100 feet of the primary exterior entrance used by voters in which voting is taking place, or with persons standing in line to vote.

A person shall not enter or remain in the area except for the purpose of entering or leaving the building for lawful purposes where voting is taking place.

Electioneering Includes:

- ★ Handing out, distributing, or offering to hand out or distribute campaign literature or literature regarding a candidate, issue, or measure on the ballot.
- ★ Soliciting signatures on any petition.
- **★** Soliciting contributions.
- ★ Displaying a candidate's name, likeness, or logo.
- ★ Displaying a ballot measure's number, title, subject, or logo.
- ★ Displaying or dissemination of buttons, hats, pencils, pens, shirts, signs, or stickers containing electioneering information.
- ★ Disseminating audible electioneering information.

PUNISHMENT

Violation of electioneering laws is, at the minimum, a Class A misdemeanor offense punishable by fine or confinement.
