Upon recommendation, an amended resolution has been submitted to change the runoff to March 29<sup>th</sup>. The previous date would not have given sufficient time to prepare for the runoff.

### **Other Business**

The Arkansas County Election Commissioners Association will hold their winter meeting February 4, 2011. Ms. Allen requested membership to the association for the remaining staff members to attend meetings for this year.

Commissioner Wyrick objected to additional staff membership. The costs of membership and travel expenses, in the long run, of meetings taking place in other parts of the state would bear undue additional costs. Until he can see that the ACECA is a viable organization, he will continue to object to additional staff membership.

Commissioner Snider suggested limited meeting attendance to local meetings only.

Motion to allow additional staff members and limiting meeting attendance to local meetings at this time made by Commissioner Snider; seconded by Commissioner Walker; opposed by Commissioner Wyrick. All in favor; Chairman Walker, Commissioner Snider voted for; Commissioner Wyrick, voted against.
