# **Other Business**

Ms. Allen presented the Commission a letter written by Justice of the Peace Judy Green alleging improprieties committed by her opponent in the 2012 Preferential Primary in May. County Attorney Karla Hutchens spoke on the matter, and let the Commission know that she had previously advised Ms. Green of her options in the spring. She stated that at this point the only action available to the Commission at this point was to forward the letter to Prosecuting Attorney Larry Jegley. Ms. Allen stated that the letter would be forwarded to the Mr. Jegley.

Ms. Allen provided the commissioners with the September Statement of Operations.

Ms. Allen informed the commission that staff members were finishing the Logic and Accuracy Testing for the General Election today, as the programming and testing of these particular machines had to be delayed due to the Maumelle Special Election and the Annual School Runoff election, due to a shortage of equipment.

Ms. Allen informed the Commission that Pollworker training was going to be conducted this Saturday, and on three evenings next week.

Ms. Allen also pointed out that early voting for the General Election will be starting on October 22, 2012.
