Approval of Meeting Minutes

Commissioner Boyle moved to accept the minutes with corrections; seconded by Commissioner Harris-Ritter. Motion passed by voice vote.

Business

Provisional Ballot Hearing for Maumelle Special Election

There were 10 provisional ballots for the Maumelle Special Election. Five of the provisional ballots were eligible to be counted and five were not eligible to be counted. There were 20 Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) ballots sent out, none were returned. Commissioner Harris-Ritter moved for the certification of the provisional ballots; seconded by Commissioner Boyle. Motion passed by voice vote.

Certification of the Official Results for Maumelle Special Election

There were 1,409 votes for the Sales and Use Tax for the City of Maumelle and 1,251 against. There were 1,340 votes for the Street Improvements Bond and 1,321 against. There were 1,275 votes for the Sewer Improvement Bond and 1,382 against. Commissioner Boyle moved for the certification of the official results of the Maumelle Special Election; seconded by Commissioner Harris-Ritter. Motion passed by voice vote.

Certification of Ballot Styles for the Preferential Primary/Nonpartisan Election
There are 157 Republican ballot styles; 174 Democrat ballot styles; 150 Nonpartisan ballot styles for a total of 481 ballot styles. Commissioner Boyle moved for the certification of the ballot styles; seconded by Commissioner Harris-Ritter. Motion passed by voice vote.

Other Business

Commissioner Harris-Ritter moved for adjournment of the meeting; seconded by Commissioner Boyle. Motion passed by voice vote.
