Chad Hunter, a candidate for Justice of the Peace, District 1, withdrew his name from the ballot on March 6, 2012. It was discovered that Mr. Hunter resides in JP District 2.

Logic and Accuracy Testing for the Preferential Primary Nonpartisan Judicial Election will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 27, 2012 at the Election Commission Office and will continue at Election Commission Warehouse until complete.

Mrs. Allen notified the board members of the following publication dates in the Arkansas Democrat Gazette for this election: the L&A Notice on March 23rd and the Notice of Election on April 29th and May 11th.

The early voting sites for the May Primary Election will consist of the following number of iVotronic voting devices: Main Site - 17; Laman Library & Thompson Library, 7 each; all other locations, 5 each.

Scott Price, County Clerk's Office, stated that voter registration cards have been mailed out since completion of redistricting. New cards reflecting the change of voter precinct location in Precinct 111 will be mailed out in about two weeks.
