The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Ozell Snider. A quorum was determined; all members present.

Approval of Meeting Minutes, July 13, 2012

It was moved by Chairman Snider and seconded by Commissioner Inman. All in favor; motion passed unanimously.

Little Rock, Special Election, September 11, 2012

Approval of Notice of Election Temporary Changes

Precinct 83, Antioch Baptist Church, has rescinded their participation as a polling location. This was a new polling location replacing David O. Dodd. They experienced difficulties with one of the candidate's campaigners and decided it was not in their best interest to remain a polling location. Temporary location for this election will be Precinct 84 - Iglesia Bautista "Neuva Jersulen".

Because of low voter eligibility, Precinct 63 will temporarily be placed at The Church at Rock Creek.

It was moved by Commissioner Inman and seconded by Chairman Snider to approve Notice of Election. All in favor; motion passed unanimously.

Certification of Ballot Styles

It was moved by Commissioner Inman and seconded by Chairman Snider to certify ballot styles. All in favor; motion passed unanimously.

September 18, 2012 Annual School Election

Pulaski County Special School District (no school board) and North Little Rock School District (only uncontested candidates; no millage) will not have polling locations open on Election Day. Little Rock School District will have polling locations open in Zones 6 & 7. All other zones will vote absentee and early voting.

Approval of Notice of Election

It was moved by Commissioner Inman and seconded by Chairman Snider to approve the notice of election. All in favor; motion passed unanimously.

Certification of Ballot Styles

It was moved by Commissioner Inman and seconded by Chairman Snider to certify ballot styles. All in favor; motion passed unanimously.

Other Business

Commissioner Inman asked if the commission is well equipped to handle the Little Rock Special Election and the Annual School Election simultaneously. Mrs. Allen assured the board that the commission has ample voting equipment, deliveries will be handled accordingly, etc. L & A testing for the General Election will be delayed but will be conducted in accordance with the deadline period provided by law.

L & A testing for the Little Rock Special Election and Annual School Election will be July 23, 2012 beginning at 8:30 a.m.
